### **September 28<sup>th</sup>-**

We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. Romans 6:4

### **October 5<sup>th</sup>**

John 1:14 The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

**October 12<sup>th</sup>**

Matthew 28:19-20 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

**October 19<sup>th</sup>**

He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, <sup>7</sup> so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life. Titus 3:5-7

**October 26<sup>th</sup>**

**November 2<sup>nd</sup>**

For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. Romans 10:10

**November 16<sup>th</sup>**

## Confirmation Memory Work - Spring Semester

### January 11<sup>th</sup>

I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried.

**What does this mean?** I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, from God the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the Virgin Mary, is my Lord.

### January 18<sup>th</sup>

He descended into Hell. The Third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.

**What does this mean?** Who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned person, purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil; not with money but with His holy, precious blood and with His innocent suffering and death,

### January 25<sup>th</sup>

And Jesus said to them, "Let us go on to the next towns, that I may preach there also, for that is why I came out. And he went throughout all Galilee, preaching in their synagogues and casting out demons. Mark 1:38-39

### February 1<sup>st</sup>

Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name. John 20:30-31

### February 8<sup>th</sup>

**What is the sacrament of the Altar?** It is the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ under the bread and wine, instituted by Christ Himself for us Christians to eat and to drink.

### February 15<sup>th</sup>

Such a high priest truly meets our need—one who is holy, blameless, pure, set apart from sinners, exalted above the heavens. <sup>27</sup> Unlike the other high priests, he does not need to offer sacrifices day after day, first for his own sins, and then for the sins of the people. He sacrificed for their sins once for all when he offered himself. Hebrews 7:26-27

### February 22<sup>nd</sup>

**What is the benefit of this eating and drinking?** The chief blessing of the Sacrament is the forgiveness of sins which Christ's body and blood have won for us on the cross.

### March 1<sup>st</sup>

He was despised and rejected by mankind, a man of suffering, and familiar with pain. Like one from whom people hide their faces he was despised, and we held him in low esteem. Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. Isaiah 53:4-5.

**March 8<sup>th</sup>**

The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and give His life as a ransom for many. Mark 10:45

**March 15<sup>th</sup>****Third Article of Apostles Creed**

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

**What does this mean?** I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, but through the help of the Holy Spirit who makes me holy and keeps me in the faith I am called by the Gospel to use my gifts and talents to serve the Lord.
